- The Museum of New Zealand Te Papa Tongarewa is a Crown entity that operates under the Museum of New Zealand Te Papa Tongarewa Act 1992. The principal agent for Te Papa in this MOU is Dame Claudia Orange, Director of Collections and Research at Te Papa.

This support will primarily take the form of working with Wendy McGuinness to progress public engagement initiatives concerned with the Constitutional Review, and in particular a two day event planned for late August or early September with 40 young people between the ages of 18 to 30.
